
Remittances

• 36 billion in 2019

Family Remittances to Mexico (Billions USD)

 3 percent of GDP in Mexico and 20 percent in Honduras

 Experts predict remittances to Latin America will decrease by at least 7 percent





Tourism

Accounts for 8.5 percent of GDP

 2019: 44 million tourists (11 million Americans)

Spring break, 40 percent decline

Immigration

- MPP: 62,000 asylum seekers, 15,000 on waitlists
- Covid-19: immigration courts closed, border closed for asylum seekers
- Executive order: 60-day suspension of green cards (with exceptions)
